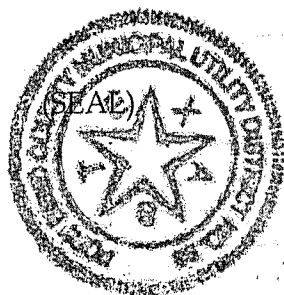
### FORT BEND COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 23

The Board of Directors of Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 23 will hold a regular meeting on **Thursday, March 23, 2017, at 6:00 p.m.**, at the offices of Allen Boone Humphries Robinson LLP, Phoenix Tower, Suite 2400, San Jacinto Room, 3200 Southwest Freeway, Houston, Texas, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

1. Public comments.
2. CONSENT AGENDA: The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event the item will be removed and placed on the Non-Consent Agenda.
  - a. Approve minutes.
  - b. Garbage and recycling matters.
  - c. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
  - d. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs and maintenance, customer correspondence, message language on bills, and delinquent back charges.
  - e. TCEQ Phase II Small MS4 General Permit, including status of compliance, necessary training, and public comment.
  - f. Administrative manager matters, including:
    - i. administration building; and
    - ii. newsletter and websites.

    - i. update on pending repairs and authorize additional repairs and improvements as appropriate;

- l. Report on Series 2017 refunding bond issue.
- m. Series 2017A Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, including:
  - i. disclosures pursuant to Municipal Securities Rulemaking Board requirements;
  - ii. authorize tax assessor/collector to request Certificate of Assessed Value as of January 1 from the Appraisal District;
  - iii. engage Moody's Investors Service to perform credit rating analysis for Series 2017A Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds;
  - iv. approve Preliminary Official Statement for the District's Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2017A;
  - v. designate Underwriter;
  - vi. appoint Paying Agent/Registrar and Escrow Agent;
  - vii. adopt Resolution Authorizing the Issuance of the District's Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2017A and authorize the Board of Directors to sign all documents relating to the sale of the bonds;
  - viii. authorize the District's attorney and the financial advisor to take all necessary action in connection with the issuance of the District's Unlimited Tax Refunding Bonds, Series 2017A;
  - ix. execution of Certificate Regarding Provision of Financial Advice; and
  - x. approve check to Attorney General relating to bond issue transcript review.
