

2. **CONSENT AGENDA:** The following items are considered routine by the Board and will be enacted by one motion. No separate discussion will occur on these items unless a Board member so requests, in which event the item will be removed and placed on the Non-Consent Agenda.
 - a. Approve minutes.
 - b. Review Final Arbitrage Rebate Report for the Series 2007 Bonds.
 - c. Tax assessment and collection matters, including delinquent tax collections, installment agreements, and payment of tax bills.
 - d. Operation of District facilities, including billings, repairs and maintenance, customer correspondence, message language on bills, and delinquent back charges.
 - e. TCEQ Phase II Small MS4 General Permit, including status of compliance, necessary training, and public comment.

 - cc. water plant nos. 1 and 2 recoating;
 - dd. wastewater treatment plant bar screen replacement;
 - ee. effluent reuse facilities at the wastewater treatment plant;
 - ii. review bids, award contracts and approve letter financing agreements for projects in the District, including:
 - aa. Trammel Fresno Road expansion project and related relocation of District facilities;
 - iii. approve pay estimates, change orders and final acceptance as appropriate, including:
 - aa. Cambridge Falls, Section 10;
 - bb. Cambridge Falls, Section 11;
 - cc. lift station generators;
 - iv. renewal of wastewater treatment plant permit;
 - v. proposal for rerating the wastewater treatment plant;
 - vi. Sycamore/Rabb Road extension and proposed land swap;
 - vii. Chimney Rock Road extension;
 - viii. South Post Oak Boulevard extension;
 - ix. deeds, easements or utility conveyances;
 - x. requests for consents to encroachments or utility commitment letters; and
 - xi. proposed annexations, including:
 - aa. approve annexation agreement; and
 - bb. authorize engineer to prepare feasibility study;
 - xii. consider expanding the regional water system to include additional Fort Bend County Municipal Utility District No. 24 facilities;
 - xiii. consider request from Skymark Development Company, Inc. for temporary water and sewer capacity to serve tracts of land that may be annexed into Fort Bend County Municipal Utility

District No. 24 and, if appropriate, approve related documents including capacity agreement.

- i. Additional operating matters, including:
 - i. update on installation of smart meters in the District; and
 - ii. hearing on the termination of water and sewer service to delinquent customers, authorize termination of service, and process uncollectible accounts as applicable.
- j. Hurricane Harvey related matters, including status of District facilities and operations and approval of any related agreements and applications for financial assistance.
- k. Amend Rate Order.
- l. District security matters, including approve Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with Fort Bend County for security patrol.
- m. Reports from Directors and District consultants on District operations.
